The "Guidelines for Operating Caucuses of the DNC," as adopted in January 1999, state that a member of a Constituency Caucus shall sign an affirmative statement indicating his/her desire to be a member of the Caucus once every four years. In order to be a voting participant of the Caucus, a member must be a duly elected member of the DNC and share the "inherent and immutable traits" that define the Caucus.
