ON WED 24 FEB 2010, AT APPROX 0900 HRS, OFFICER MINIUM AND DET SGT KING CONDUCTED INTERVIEWS IN THE 600 BLK OF S 2ND ST AFTER RECEIVING A 4TH COMPLAINT OF SEXUAL CRIMES AGAINST STEELTON MAYOR THOMAS ACRI RECEIVED A LETTER FROM CHILDREN. WES SAKMAR WHICH WAS FORWARDED FROM REP TIM HOLDEN.

THE LETTER STATES THAT THERE IS "SEX SLAVE HOUSE" AT 607 S 2ND ST, STEELTON, WHICH WAS SIGNED BY WES SAKMAR. THE LETTER WERE SEVERAL PHOTOS OF THAT HOUSE AND PEOPLE / KIDS STANDING OUT FRONT. THE PHOTOS SHOWED NO CRIMINAL ACTIVITY.

KING AND MINIUM SPOKE WITH SEVERAL NEIGHBORS ABOUT THE ALLEGATIONS. ALL THE NEIGHBORS STATED THAT THE RESIDENTS AT 607 S 2ND ST ARE GOOD PEOPLE WHO ARE GOOD NEIGHBORS. OF THE PARTIES INTERVIEWED REPORTED ANY SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITIES COMING FROM 607 S 2ND ST AND ALL APPEARED TO BE SUPRISED THAT THESE ALLEGATIONS ARE STILL BEING MADE.

AFTER THE INTERVIEWS WHICH WERE CONDUCTED BETWEEN 0900 HRS AND 1000 HRS, KING AND MINIUM MADE AN UNANNOUNCED VISIT TO 607 S 2ND ST AND MADE CONTACT WITH LARRY COLFIELD SR AND LARRY COLFIELD JR. BOTH WERE ADVISED OF THE ALLEGATIONS, AT WHICH TIME LARRY SR STATED THAT WANTED TO FILE CHARGES SINCE THIS IS ONGOING. LARRY SR ALLOWED POLICE TO CHECK OUT THE HOUSE WHICH REVEALED NOTHING SUSPICIOUS OR CRIMINAL.

THE FIRST COMPLAINT RECEIVED FROM WES SAKMAR WAS ON 5-23-2008 (STL 20080500774). IN THAT COMPLAINT SAKMAR STATED THAT THE NEIGHBOR WHO RESIDE AT 607 S 2ND ST IS SEXUALLY ASSAULTING HIS 16 YEAR OLD DAUGHTER. THIS INCIDENT WAS INVESTIGATED BY OFFICER RUPERT AND WAS TO BE UNFOUNDED. ON 16 MAR 2010, OFFICER MINIUM REC'D A 2ND NCMEC PACKET. THE NCMEC REC'D A 2ND COMPLAINT FROM WES SAKMAR.

THE COMPLAINT WAS THEN FORWARDED TO STEELTON POLICE. ATTACHED WAS A LETTER SIGNED BY SAKMAR WHICH HAD SOME SAFETY CONCERNS FOR THE VICTIMS (COLFIELDS).

OFFICER MINIUM CONTACTED THE DAUPHIN COUNTY DA'S OFFICE AND SPOKE WITH ADA JOEL HOGENTOGLER IN REF TO THE THREATENING LETTER.

HOGENTOGLER ADVISED NOT TO FILE ANY CHARGES AT THIS TIME AND ADVISED TO KEEP A GOOD EYE ON THE SITUATION. HOGENTOGLER ADVISED THAT BOTH THE COUNTY AND THE BORO WERE FREE FROM ANY LIABILITY.

> THE THIRD INCIDENT REPORTED BY WES SAKMAR WAS ON 7-28-2008 (STL 20080701041). WES SAKMAR FILED A REPORT WITH THE NATIONAL CENTER OF MISSING AND EXPLOITED CHILDREN. IN THAT REPORT SAKMAR STATED THAT HE OBSERVES CHILDREN BEING TAKEN IN AND OUT OF 607 C 200 CT. OUT OF 607 S 2ND ST. HE ALSO REPORTED THAT LARRY COLFIELD SR IMPREGNATED SPECIFIC UNIDENTIFIED CHILDREN. THIS INCIDENT WAS INVESTIGATED BY OFFICER ELHAJJ AND WAS UNFOUNDED.

THE FOURTH INCIDENT REPORTED BY WES SAKMAR WAS ON 5-26-2009 (STL 20090500768). STEELTON POLICE WERE ADVISED OF POSSIBLE SEX OFFENES AT 607 S 2ND ST AFTER SEVERAL LETTERS AND PHOTOS WERE SENT TO CHURCHES IN OTHER JURISDICTIONS. IN THOSE LETTERS SAKMAR ASK FOF THE CHURCHES TO PRAY FOR THE CHILDREN BORNED IN CAPTIVITY AT 607 S 2ND ST STEELTON. THE LETTERS STATE THAT 2 SADISTIC CHILD MOLESTING PIMPS OWN 2 TEENAGE WHITE GIRLS. THIS INVESTIGATION WAS HANDLED BY OFFICER MINIUM WHICH REVEALED THAT SAKMAR WAS REFERRING TO SAM BIXLER AND JUITH BRUBAKER AS THE TWO GIRLS BEING ASSAULTED BY THEIR FATHER, LARRY COFIELD SR.

OFFICER MINIUM COMPLETED INTERVIEWS WITH NEIGHBORS IN THE 600 BLK OF S 2ND ST. NO ONE REPORTED ANY SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY OR CONCERNS WITH 607 S 2ND ST AND MOST WERE AWARE OF AN ONGOING PROBLEM BETWEEN SAKMAR AND THE COFIELDS. ALL PARTIES INTERVIEWED STATED THAT THE COFIELDS ARE GOOD NEIGHBORS WHO ARE BEING RACIALLY HARASSED BY WES SAKMAR, SINCE THEY ARE A BI-RACIAL FAMILY. OFFICER MINIUM MADE AN UNANNOUNCED VISIT TO 607 S 2ND ST STEELTON AND MADE CONTACT WITH JUDY COFIELD. JUDY ALLOWED MINIUM INTO HER HOUSE TO CHECK THINGS OUT WHICH REVEALED NOTHING SUSPICIOUS OR CRIMINAL. JUDY WAS ADVISED OF THE ALLEGATIONS AND BEFORE BEING ADVISED WHO REPORTED THIS, SHE STATED THAT SHE THOUGHT IT WAS SAKMAR SINCE THERE WAS AN ONGOING PROBLEM. THESE PROBLEMS WERE VERIFIED THROUGH METRO REPORTS.

OFFICER MINIUM AND OFFICER ELHAJJ THEN MADE CONTACT WITH SAKMAR AT HIS RESIDENCE. SAKMAR DID NOT REPORT ANY CRIMINAL ACTIVITY EXCEPT THAT HE THINKS THE KIDS THERE ARE BEING SEXUALLY ASSAULTED. MINIUM ADVISED HIM THAT THE INVESTIGATION ONCE AGAIN REVEALED NOTHING CRIMINAL.

OFFICER MINIUM DID FIND SEVERAL REPORTS IN METRO WHICH SHOW SAKMAR HAVING ISSUES WITH MUSLIMS AND OR BLACK NEIGHBORS. MIDDLETOWN POLICE HAD FOUR OF THESE REPORTS AND STEELTON HAD AN REPORT IN WHICH SAKMAR GOT INTO A FIGHT WITH A BLACK MALE OVER RELIGION (STL 20071000669), BESIDE THE INCIDENTS STATED ABOVE.

OFFICER MINIUM CONTACTED ADA JACE CANAVAN IN REFERENCE TO THIS CASE WHO APPROVED CHARGES TO BE FILED.

### Sen. Leach: Human trafficking is in your own back yard

Believe it or not, Upper Merion is a hotbed for human trafficking and Pennsylvania is a major hub of this illegal trade, State Sen. Daylin Leach, D-17th, of Montgomery and Delaware counties, said during Thursday night's town hall meeting.

Some 100,000 young girls in America are brought into prostitution rings, said Leach, who recently introduced a Senate bill which would require signage at businesses alerting people of a special human trafficking relief hotline.

"It's modern-day slavery," he told Plymouth residents.

"Some are foreign nationals who are told they have a debt to pay and that they have to work it off. The average age at which this occurs is 13 years old. It's a horrible situation."

According to Leach, human trafficking is most common at restaurants, hotels, strip clubs, massage parlors and nail salons. An 8"x11" sign would advertise a hotline number to call and impose duties on prothonotaries.

"It's free, it's confidential and it's not run by the government, so people will get the help they need," said Leach.

"Whether you are a victim, or you know a victim, if someone works at a facility where (human trafficking) happens, they will see that sign every day."

The senator named Toledo, Ohio, as the No. 1 area of reported human trafficking incidents, with Pennsylvania among the top four states in the country having it. But human trafficking is not a pandemic restricted to immigrants. In some cases, American young women, most often runaways, fall subject to this crime.

While Leach said he thought his legislation would be a "no-brainer" to pass, he gave the name of one member of the General Assembly who opposed it. John Gordener, R-27th Dist., of Columbia, Montour and Snyder counties, could not be reached for comment at press time.

In other news, Leach, who said he worked at his Senate job on an average of 80 hours a week, warned of the repercussions of Thursday morning's Commonwealth Court decision regarding MCare funds. In an effort to resolve the state's longstanding budget dilemma, the General Assembly transferred millions of dollars from MCare fund. The court ruled, 4-1, to return those funds.

"The court said the money transferred from the MCare fund to the general fund was transferred illegally," Leach told The Times Herald.

"The governor said he would appeal this decision, but if it does stand, it makes it much more difficult to pass a balanced budget. We had a \$700 million hold, and now it more than doubles what our problem was."

MILLER WITNESSED SAKMAR WALK OUT HIS FRONT DOOR, PAST HIS MOTHER'S HOUSE THEN AROUND BACK TO GET TO HIS CAR WHICH WAS PARKED BEHIND HIS HOUSE. MILLER STATED THAT SAKMAR WOULD LOOK AT HIM AND WOULD SMURK AT HIM AS HE WALKED PAST. MILLER ADVISED THAT SAKMAR WOULD HAVE TO GO OUT OF HIS WAY TO WALK PAST HIS MOTHER'S HOUSE TO GET TO HIS CAR, SINCE SAKMAR HAS A BACKDOOR AND THERE ARE SHORTER PATHS TO GET TO HIS CAR.

MILLER STATED THAT SAKMAR'S BEHAVIOR HAS CHANGED SINCE HE TESTIFIED. PRIOR TO MILLER TESTIFYING AGAINST SAKMAR, THERE WERE NO PROBLEMS AND SAKMAR NEVER WALKED PAST HIS MOTHER'S

### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Claimant was last employed on 9/18/2006.
- 2. The Claimant's job title was Boiler Maker.
- 3. The Claimant was discharged for: lack of accountability for an evacuation.
- 4. The Claimant was working at the time of the incident which caused the separation.
- 5. The Claimant did not admit to the incident which caused the separation.
- 6. This determination has been made with all available information.

#### DISCUSSION

In situations where a claimant is discharged, the burden of proof is on the employer to show the claimant's actions which caused the separation constitute willful misconduct. Willful misconduct is defined as a willful disregard of the employer's interests, a deliberate violation of the employer's rules, a disregard for the standards of behavior which the employer has the right to expect, or negligence which demonstrates wrongful intent or intentional and substantial disregard of the employer's interests or the employer's duties and obligations. In this case, the claimant did not admit to the incident which caused the separation and the employer did not submit sufficient information to sustain it's burden of proof. As such, benefits must be allowed under Section 402(e).

### **DETERMINATION**

The Claimant is eligible for benefits under Section 402(e) of the Pennsylvania Unemployment Compensation Law beginning with compensable week ending 11/11/2006.
